EISTEDDFOD BANDS & ORCHESTRAS MAKE TRIUMPHANT RETURN

The Australian National Eisteddfod's Bands & Orchestras event made a fantastic return to live format on May 25-31.

"It's great to be back performing live" captured the spirit of the event and its participants (around 2,000 members in 70 bands, orchestras and ensembles).

A highlight of the event was the Open Concert and Brass Bands in Llewellyn Hall on Friday 26 May.

Canberra Brass, Canberra City Band and John Agnew Band were all given Platinum awards for outstanding performances (for the first time Open age sections were non-competitive).

Canberra Brass, directed by Veronica Boulton, used their 20 minutes well to perform a variety of works – from an arrangement of Winter (from Vivaldi's Four Seasons) to the 1940s Yes Indeed! spiritual which included the band singing and a work written by a member of the band, Gypsy Cook.

Canberra City Band, conducted by Shilong Ye, performed the third suite of Folksongs for Band by David Stanhope, which are dedicated to the memory of Percy Grainger.

John Agnew Band performed three contrasting pieces, under the baton of Jenna Hinton.

Ginninderra Wind Orchestra and the Hunter School of the Performing Arts Senior and Junior Concert Bands received Gold Awards in the A, B and C grade Open Concert Bands respectively, and Victoria Street Brass Silver in Open B Grade Brass Bands.

The main Adjudicator, Dr Jemima Bunn from Melbourne, was impressed with the repertoire chosen and overall standard. Over the 68 groups taking part there were 9 Platinum awards, 32 Gold and 28 Silver. She reflected on what an amazing opportunity the Eisteddfod offers as a vibrant and exciting event supporting youth and community music in and around Canberra.
