Melissa Buchholz of Toowoomba Grammar School and Mr Glenn Riddle of Melbourne Conservatorium of Music, University of Melbourne adjudicated a record number of over four hundred and fifty performances ranging from 7 years and under age group to the Open sections.

The final event on Sunday 3 September, the Open Piano Championship, attracted 12 entrants coming from Canberra, Sydney, Brisbane, Gold Coast, Wagga Wagga and Melbourne. The winner of the first prize of \$4,000 was Oscar Wong from the Gold Coast with second prize of \$2,000 going to Bernice Chua of Canberra

Overall, there were 65 sections and those winners plus placegetters as well as the special awards are now available on the Eisteddfod website.
