

GUIDE TO UPLOAD MUSIC FILES IN STARDOM AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL EISTEDDFOD (CHOIR)

Step 1 - Log in into Stardom

- Log into Stardom and locate your Australian National Eisteddfod entry in the bottom half of your home page under the heading “Completed Entries”.

- On the far right side under “Other Actions” you should see a treble clef symbol and a “Performance Item” link. Click on that link.

Step 3 - Providing details and files for your performances

- For each section you have entered, provide all the details for “Performance Item 1” and “Performance Item 2” in the boxes provided.
- For “Music Sheet 1”, provide in the box under “Accompanist or Backing Track” whether you will have an accompanist or a backing track or non required for this performance.
- Click on Choose File link on the right and upload your music score in PDF format.
- For “Music Sheet 2”, provide in the box under “Accompanist or Backing Track” whether you will have an accompanist or a backing track or non required for this performance.
- Click on Choose File link on the right and upload your music score in PDF format.

If you are using backing track for one or more of your performance(s), please do the following, otherwise go to Step 4:

- For “Backing Track 1” (this is for your performance item 1), click on “Choose File” link on the right and upload your music file in MP3, MA4 or WAV.
- If you would like to provide any comments, please use the “Optional Comments” box.
- For “Backing Track 2”, (this is for your performance item 2), click on “Choose File” link on the right and upload your music file in MP3, MA4 or WAV.
- If you would like to provide any comments, please use the “Optional Comments” box.

Step 4 - Saving your changes

- At any stage during this process, you can scroll to the very bottom of the page and click on “Save Changes” button. We strongly recommend to do this regularly if you have a large number of files to upload.
